1. Term 3 Message from Principal

Greetings and a warm welcome back to school to all BGPIans for Term 3! We ended the last semester on a high note for students to discover their talents, shine, and celebrate through our superbly organised Talent Fiesta Day. This year's Talent Fiesta unveiled numerous hidden talents among our BGPIans – we discovered brilliant hip-hop dancers and highly-flexible gymnasts, passionate and dynamic musicians and singers, skillful cup stackers, five-stone specialists and ping-pong ball catchers who demonstrated supreme levels of hand-eye coordination and focus – with the much-coveted Talent Fiesta Champion Class Shield eventually ending up in the hands of P5 Integrity. Even our Grassroots Advisor, Mr Dinesh Vasu Dash, made a surprise visit to join in some of the activities and to engage with many of our BGPIans, staff and Parent Volunteers. I am grateful for our staff for all the efforts made to put together a truly memorable day for our BGPIans.

With Talent Fiesta having bookended the last few weeks of the previous term's curriculum, the new semester will open with a special in-curriculum Student Development Day on the very first day on 30 June. Named 'Ready, Steady, Grow!', the first day of the new semester will be set aside for students to ease into school through a specially designed workshop, focusing on the theme of cultivating a Growth Mindset for all students. This mindset, which emphasises that abilities and intelligence can be developed through effort, perseverance, and continuous learning, plays a vital role in shaping students' long-term success. For the lower primary, they will experience the Ready Stage by being introduced to growth mindset concepts through interactive storytelling, games and engaging workshops. For the middle primary – the Steady Stage – their understanding of growth mindset will be strengthened by application of its principles to real-world personal contexts, aligned with our middle primary theme of We are Stronger Together. The upper primary will undergo the Grow Stage, where they will undertake experiential learning activities such as station or board games, small-group challenges and hands-on experiences and application to apply themselves according to the upper primary theme of The Sky is the Limit. We hope that starting the semester right by equipping students with the confidence to embrace challenges, adapt to change, remain motivated in the face of setbacks and cultivating a desire of continued personal growth, will remind students to take ownership of their learning and actions, setting the stage for success for the second half of the year.

Similar to the previous year, we will again be introducing three sessions of in-curriculum foundational coding programme for P2 students in Term 3 as part of our Be Digitally Lit! @ BGPS Programme. They will learn about basic concepts of coding, robotics, and their applications in daily lives through gameplay and storytelling. Students will also get to work in teams to code their robots to complete challenges. More details will be provided when the schedule is finalized. With regard to school infrastructure updates, I am very pleased to share that the installation of air-conditioning in the school's Multi-Purpose Hall is finally completed. This new facility will ensure greater comfort for our students during assemblies and school events. In addition, the fence line along Bedok Ave 2 has been repaired to enhance the safety and security of our school premises.

As we look forward to the coming July and August, where we will be commemorating key National Education events for Racial Harmony Day and our SG60 National Day, I would like to rally our BGPIans and our immediate community to also reflect on our nation's journey, and to be grateful for what Singapore has provided for us over the last 60 years – in our opportunities, our education, our livelihoods and the roofs over our heads. While no country can ever be perfect, we want to remind BGPIans to keep themselves aware of what is happening in the world, and that in comparison, we need be strong together as one united people. As per this year's NDP 2025 theme, Here We Are, Singapore has come a rather long way for 60 years, and the next generation must continue to rise up

and be counted to bring Singapore through to SG100. I therefore encourage all parents to continue journeying with us in the education of our BGPIans, and wish all BGPIans a great time of learning and growth in BGPS till the end of the year!
